

## **DESCRIPTION**

CH008 consists of a round table top on a frame with three detachable, tapered legs. To support the table top, and as a link between the top and the legs, the table has a solid triangular frame, the corners of which are cut off at an angle at the edge of the table top. The legs are screwed into these surfaces to achieve their slanted outward direction. The rounding of the legs gives the coffee table an elegant and almost floating look. With only 3 legs, the coffee table is also well suited for slightly uneven floors.

# **DESIGNER**

Danish architect Hans J. Wegner (1914–2007) is considered a pioneering furniture designer of the twentieth century. Often referred to as the master of the chair, Wegner created almost 500 in his lifetime – many of them considered masterpieces. Wegner was part of the spectacular generation that created what is today referred to as 'the Golden Age' of modern Danish design. Almost all of the world's major design museums, from the Museum of Modern Art in New York and Designmuseum Danmark in Copenhagen to Die Neue Sammlung in Munich, exhibit his works.

# MATERIALS

Solid oak with soap, lacquer, oil, white oil, or black paint. Note that oak has a clearly visible wood structure when painted. Solid walnut in lacquer or oil.

### PREASSEMBLED

No. The three table legs must be mounted by the costumer.

## PRODUCTION PROCESS

All parts are CNC machined and then polished and assembled by hand.
